CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION GRANT DRAW DOWN: Moved by Twombly and seconded by Hoadley for Auditor Berg, as contract administrator, to sign the Child Abuse Prevention Grant Draw Dow. Approved.

HOSPITAL AUDIT: Moved by Baier and seconded by Wedemeyer to acknowledge receipt of the FY23 & FY24 Adair County Memorial Hospital Audit. Approved.

VETERANS' AFFAIRS: Gwen Johnston, County VA Director and John Schildberg III, VA Commissioner, entered at 9:03 a.m. Schildberg stated that it has gotten to the point that Johnston can no longer handle everything with all of the new vets and pensions she is working on and they would like to see the Veterans' Affairs office open more. The Commissioners have agreed that another part-time person is needed. They would like this person to work 12 hours a week, which would allow them to open Mondays for 8 hours and then the person would assist Gwen a few hours a week as well. The new hire would not have access to veterans' files or the database. Moved by Twombly and seconded by Baier to allow the Veterans' Affairs office to post the job and hire a part-time person. Approved. Johnston and Schildberg exited and Jotham Arber entered at 9:09 a.m.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH: Jotham Arber, Environmental Health Coordinator, gave the Board an update on environmental health. They are coming to the end of perc test for the year although, they will continue to do them until the frost is too much. If there happens to be an emergency, they can do the test anytime. Arber gave an update on the water condition and wells map and the Beacon site showing septic systems. Arber stated that they can get funding from the state if there is anyone who is needing a water test or are rehabbing their well. Arber exited and Nick Kauffman entered at 9:22 a.m.

ENGINEER: Sign Contract & Performance Bond – Moved by Twombly and seconded by Baier to sign the contract and performance bond for the N7 Eureka Bridge Project L-LBRN7E—7X-01. Approved. **Maintenance & Activities Report** – Engineer Kauffman gave an update to the Board on the following projects: working on budget, have completed some interviews, Sawyer needing Avatara access, had an engineers conference last week, and discussed surrounding Counties needing Engineers. Kauffman exited 9:28 a.m.

AUDITOR: ARPA Funding – Auditor Berg stated that the definition of obligation ARPA funds now states that these funds must be in contract prior to the end of this calendar year. If funds are not contracted or spent prior to the end of this calendar year, those funds will need to be returned. The remainder of the ARPA funds was set aside for Courthouse renovations, which are currently not contracted for. Berg suggest that these ARPA funds get spent on expenses that are already planned for in our County budget, like the tax draws, and to set the money aside not spent in the General Fund for courthouse renovations. Berg also gave an option to use part of the ARPA funding for election equipment that will be needed since she had turned back \$15,000 of the ARPA funds originally set aside for election equipment. The Board discussed also just turning that money back to the General Fund and using the debt levy for Courthouse Renovations. Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Twombly to use the remaining ARPA funds for election equipment and the tax draws. Approved. **Budget Amendment** – Auditor Berg presented the budget amendment requests. Moved by Twombly and seconded by Wedemeyer to set the public hearing for the Budget Amendment for January 2, 2025 at 9:15 a.m. Approved.

ADJOURNMENT: Moved by Twombly and seconded by Baier to adjourn at 9:48 a.m. Approved.
