MONTHLY REPORTS: Moved by Wederneyer and seconded by Hoadley to acknowledge receipt of the monthly reports. Approved.

BURIAL RELIEF APPLICATION: Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Christoffersen to approve the burial relief application. Approved.

MANURE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE: Moved by Christoffersen and seconded by Hoadley to acknowledge receipt of the manure management plan updates Thompson Pork. Approved.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN – STEERING COMMITTEE: The Board discussed possible committee members for the comprehensive plan steering committee. It is suggested to have around 15 committee members that will meet three to five times and include the board of supervisors, County department heads, prominent landowners, utility providers, local government leaders, economic development leaders, etc. The Board will reach out to some of the individuals discussed to see who would be interested in serving on this committee over the next couple of weeks and this will be put back on the agenda August 6th to finalize the list to be turned into SICOG by August 7th.

GRANSTAND DEMOLITION: Supervisor Baier presented the bid to tear down, clean up, and disposed of the current grandstands. Moved by Hoadley and seconded by Christoffersen to award the bid to Redman Construction Services for \$30,000.00. Approved. Baier stated that if Redman Construction has to haul the materials themselves an additional charge may be added.

NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION URBAN RENEWAL BONDS: Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Hoadley to approve Resolution #2025-40 - Resolution Directing the Advertisement for Sale of \$5,000,000 (Dollar Amount Subject To Change) General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds, Series 2025, and Approving Electronic Bidding Procedures and Distribution of the Preliminary Official Statement. Whereas, the Issuer is in need of funds to pay costs of aiding in the planning, undertaking, and carrying out of urban renewal projects under the authority of chapter 403 and Amendment No. 2 to the Adair County Northwest Wind Farm Urban Renewal Plan including the replacement of the grandstand structure and all related demolition and site improvements at the Adair County Fairgrounds, essential county urban renewal purpose project(s), and it is deemed necessary and advisable that the County issue General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds, for such purpose(s) to the amount of not to exceed \$1,500,000 as authorized by Sections 331.443 and 403.12 of the Code of Iowa; and WHEREAS, pursuant to notice published as required by Sections 331.443 and 403.12 this Board has held a public meeting and hearing upon the proposal to institute proceedings for the issuance of said Bonds, and all objections, if any, to such Board action made by any resident or property owner of the County were received and considered by the Board; and no petition having been filed, it is the decision of the Board that additional action be taken for the issuance of said Bonds for such purpose(s), and that such action is considered to be in the best interests of the County and the residents thereof; and WHEREAS, the Issuer is in need of funds to pay costs of aiding in the planning, undertaking, and carrying out of urban renewal projects under the authority of chapter 403 and Amendment No. 2 to the Adair County Northwest Wind Farm Urban Renewal Plan including the N51 Shoulder Widening, bridge replacements, and culvert replacements, essential county urban renewal purpose project(s), and it is deemed necessary and advisable that the County issue General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds, for such purpose(s) to the amount of not to exceed \$5,000,000 as authorized by Sections 331.443 and 403.12 of the Code of Iowa; and WHEREAS, pursuant to notice published as required by Sections 331.443 and 403.12 this Board has held a public meeting and hearing upon the proposal to institute proceedings for the issuance of said Bonds, and all objections, if any, to such Board action made by any resident or property owner of the County were received and considered by the Board; and no petition having been filed, it is the decision of the Board that additional action be taken for the issuance of said Bonds for such purpose(s), and that such action is considered to be in the best interests of the County and the residents thereof: and WHEREAS, in conjunction with its Municipal Advisor, Speer Financial, Inc., the County has caused an Official Statement to be prepared outlining the details of the proposed sale of the Bonds; and WHEREAS, the Board has received information from its Municipal Advisor evaluating and recommending the procedure hereinafter described for electronic, facsimile and internet bidding to maintain the integrity and security of the competitive bidding process and to facilitate the delivery of bids by interested parties; and WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interests of the County and the residents thereof to receive bids to purchase such Bonds by means of both sealed and electronic internet communication. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ADAIR COUNTY, STATE OF IOWA: Section 1. That the receipt of electronic bids by facsimile machine and through the SpeerAuction Competitive Bidding System described in the Notice of Sale and Official Statement are hereby found and determined to provide reasonable security and to maintain the integrity of the competitive bidding process, and to facilitate the delivery of bids by interested parties in connection with the offering at public sale. Section 2. That General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds, Series 2025, of Adair County, State of Iowa, in the amount of \$5,000,000 (subject to change), to be issued as referred to in the preamble of this Resolution, to be dated September 4, 2025, be offered for sale pursuant to the published advertisement. Section 3. That the preliminary Official Statement in the form presented to this meeting be and the same hereby is approved as to form and deemed final for purposes of Rule 15c2-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission, subject to such revisions, corrections or modifications as the Chairperson and County Auditor, upon the advice of bond counsel and the County's Municipal Advisor, shall determine to be appropriate, and is authorized to be distributed in connection with the offering of the Bonds for sale. Section 4. That the Auditor is hereby directed to publish notice of sale of the Bonds at least once, the last one of which shall be not less than four clear days nor more than twenty days before the date of the sale. Publication shall be made in the "Adair County Free Press and Adair News", a legal newspaper, printed wholly in the English language, published within the county in which the Bonds are to be offered for sale or an adjacent county. The notice is given pursuant to Chapter 75 of the Code of Iowa, and shall state that this Board, on the 6th day of August, 2025, at 1:00 P.M., will hold a meeting to receive and act upon bids for said Bonds, which bids were previously received and opened by County Officials at 10:30 A.M. on said date.
