

**NOTICE TO THE ELECTORS OF THE NODAWAY VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT  
A SPECIAL PUBLIC MEASURE ELECTION WILL BE CONDUCTED ON MARCH 7, 2023**

Notice is hereby given to the registered and qualified electors of the NODAWAY VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT of Adair County and Madison County that a SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION will be held March 7, 2023.

**NOTE:** Only one polling place will be used in this election.

The **POLLING PLACE** for all voters residing within the Nodaway Valley School District in Adair County and Madison County is: Adair County Health & Fitness Center (202 N Townline Rd, Greenfield, IA).

POLLS OPEN at 7 A.M. and POLLS CLOSE at 8 P.M.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered - such as voters registering to vote on Election Day - and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) may have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by March 13, 2023, at Noon. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. Voter pre-registration deadline is 5:00 P.M. February 20, 2023, at the Adair County Auditor's office.

Absentee ballots are available in the County Auditor's office during regular business hours February 15, 2023 – March 6, 2023.

The deadline to request a mailed absentee ballot is Monday, February 20, 2023, at 5 P.M.

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle.

The public test of Adair County's voter equipment to be used in the March 7, 2023, Nodaway Valley CSD Special Election will commence at 10:00 a.m. on March 3, 2023, in the Adair County Courthouse and will continue until completed. The public is invited to attend.

**Nodaway Valley CSD Public Measure AA**

Shall the following public measure be adopted?

**Summary:** To continue to levy a voter approved physical plant and equipment property tax.

Shall the Board of Directors of the Nodaway Valley Community School District, in the Counties of Adair and Madison, State of Iowa, for the purpose of purchasing and improving grounds; constructing schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; purchasing of buildings; purchase, lease or lease-purchase of technology and equipment; paying debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; procuring or acquisition of libraries; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving, or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for energy conservation; renting facilities under Iowa Code Chapter 28E; purchasing transportation equipment for transporting students; lease purchase option agreements for school buildings or equipment; purchasing equipment authorized by law; or for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy annually, a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not to exceed One Dollar Thirty-Four Cents (\$1.34) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, or each year thereafter?
